






A. ASYCUDA World

- ASYCUDA stands for Automated Systems for Customs Data
- Electronic reporting and data processing system for all import, exports and excise entries lodged with Customs.
- ASYCUDA 2.7 to ASYCUDA++ and 2017 it has been upgraded to ASYCUDA World.
- Implemented in all our 23 declared ports in Papua New Guinea.

- 1. Automated key Customs business processes.
- 2. Automated payment of duties and taxes for cargo clearance.
- 3. Simplified documentation.
- 4. Management of trade data and statistics.






