NATIONAL SECURITY GOVERNACE

The Royal Papua New Guinea Constabulary (RPNGC) provides the overarching security network for the country and is often supported by the Papua New Guinean Defence Force (PNGDF) for border protection and patrols in remote Highland areas.





PRIVATE SECURITY SECTOR

The Private Security Sector is regulated by the Security Industries Authority (SIA) established by the Security Act 2004 and is mandated to grant security providers licenses and security guard permits to security companies.

This includes granting approval for the establishment of private security training academies and formulating the Code of Conduct and and also ensuring that only the <u>registered</u> security companies operate business to protect the integrity of the industry and promote long-term growth.

The Security Industries Authority's governing body, the Security Industries Council has on the 29th June 2024 met and established a subcommittee known as the Security Training Advisory Committee (STAC) to discuss standardized training criteria.

In 2023 there were over **570** registered security companies with over **30,000** registered guards.




INTEROPERABILITY

With the security industry having in excess of **30,000** trained and registered personnel operating within PNG we have a great source of additional security infrastructure available to support the RPNGC & PNGDF with a wide intelligence network sharing a wide range of vital information.

Great news is that there are ongoing discussions with the Minister for Internal Security to integrate key personnel from selective Tier 1 security companies.

There are multiple security WhatsApp groups in circulation which provide immediate real time validated updates and reduces the problem of 'fake news' articles spread on social media.

Additional advanced training such as Hostile Environment Awareness Training (HEAT) or Defensive Driver Training courses provides an additional layer of skills to assist individuals with staying safe and secure.
